Overview

IN a significant move towards advancing digital connectivity, the government of Mali has reportedly granted a contract worth \$117.3 million to the China International Telecommunication Construction Corporation (CITCC) to extend the country's national fibre optic network. 5 billion) from IFC and other investors will enable Orange Mali to install 300 new 4G towers and expand its fiber network to reach an estimated 300,000 households and smaller businesses in Mali. According to Agence Ecofin, the work will be carried out as part of a USD117. 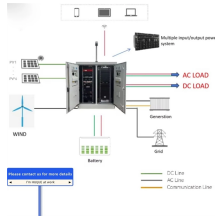
