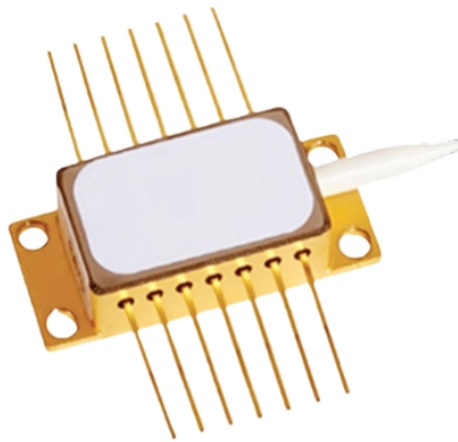


# Central Asian countries network security equipment 1G

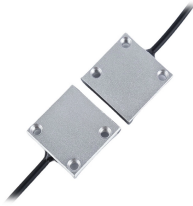


## Overview

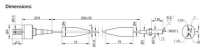

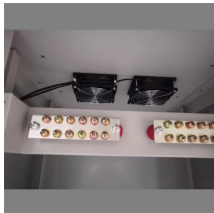
