

# Flame-retardant standards for armored optical cables

UL 1651 requirements cover single fiber and multi-fiber optical cables for control, signaling and communications as described in Article 770 and other applicable parts of the NEC. Offered in OM1, OM3 and OM4 multimode and OS2 singlemode, in 4, 8, 12 or 24 core fibre configurations. All feature a corrugated steel tape armour for protection from rodents, a central loose tube construction and internal/external LSZH. arsh environments.
