Overview

26 mm² (10 AWG) ground wire must be used, and in all other markets a 6 mm² must be used. On the US market, a 5. Then your supervisor walks by and points at the ungrounded door— "Add a wire to that!" Ugh. Here's why it matters: Static discharge: Metal doors can build up static charge, especially in high-voltage environments. Grounding of the units: Attach a ground wire from one of the threaded studs (A) at the bottom of the housing, to the mounting plate (B). Attach a second grounding wire from the mounting. The correct connection method of Distribution box grounding wire mainly includes the following steps: 1. There is a hole enabling you to bolt it to an appropriate backpanel or enclosure stud.
