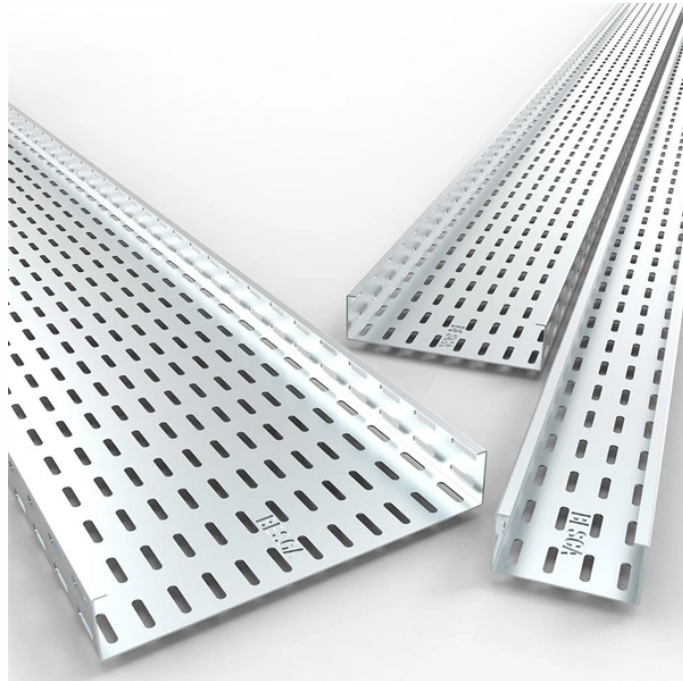

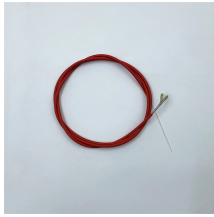

Design and installation of electrical grounding systems is one of the most important aspects of any electrical distribution system, yet it is all too often misunderstood and subsequently installed improperly.



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It requires a bonding jumper to connect the grounding terminal of a receptacle (green screw) to the metal box; with the metal box then connected to the system EGC.



Typically, the ground wire connects to the outer casing of electrical boxes, appliances, or tools. This is why the grounding conductor is also called a case ground. The grounding conductor is ...
