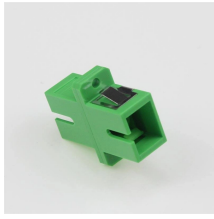

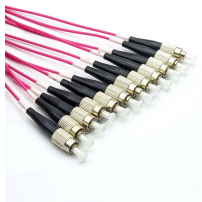
In practical implementations, conductive fiber optic cable will be bonded to the TMGB or the TGB (i.e. Central Office Ground Busbar, or COG Busbar) with a dedicated bonding conductor.

Suitable tension should be maintained to keep OPGW hanging in the air to avoid abrasion of the OPGW cable on the ground. Meanwhile, it can reduce green shoots compensation, mitigate physical labor ...



Use only shielded cable. Temperatures at the cable entry can reach 80° C. Selection of cable must be appropriate for the ambient temperature range in which the product is used.
