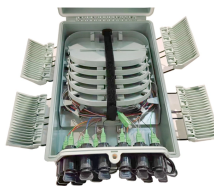
The panel should be accessible and have enough room in front of it so that an electrician can open the door and work safely. With that being said, there shouldn't be any furniture, storage items, or other obstructions blocking this. The National Electrical Code (NEC) provides comprehensive safety standards for electrical installations, including requirements for electrical panels (main service panels and subpanels or breaker box). NEC Article 408 covers switchboards, switchgear, and Panelboards installation and applications. 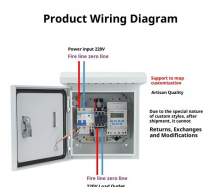

The National Electrical Code provision 110.26 clarifies that electrical boxes must be supplied with at least 3 feet of free space surrounding them for safety measures.



A common violation is storing items in front of the electrical panel, such as furniture, boxes, or cleaning supplies. This not only blocks access to the panel but also creates a fire hazard.

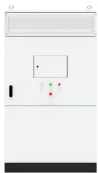
Insistence on well rather than good has resulted in a split in connotation: well is standard, neutral, and colorless, while good is emotionally charged and emphatic.

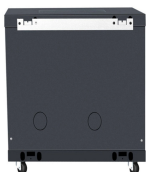
Electrical equipment must have a minimum 30" wide clear working space laterally in front of the equipment. This does not have to be centered on the equipment, but the electrical panel door ...

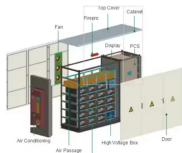
