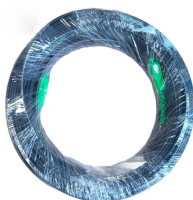
Understanding the National Electrical Code (NEC) requirements for junction boxes in homes can be confusing for the layman or even an experienced do-it-yourselfer.

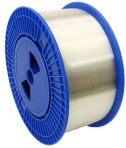
