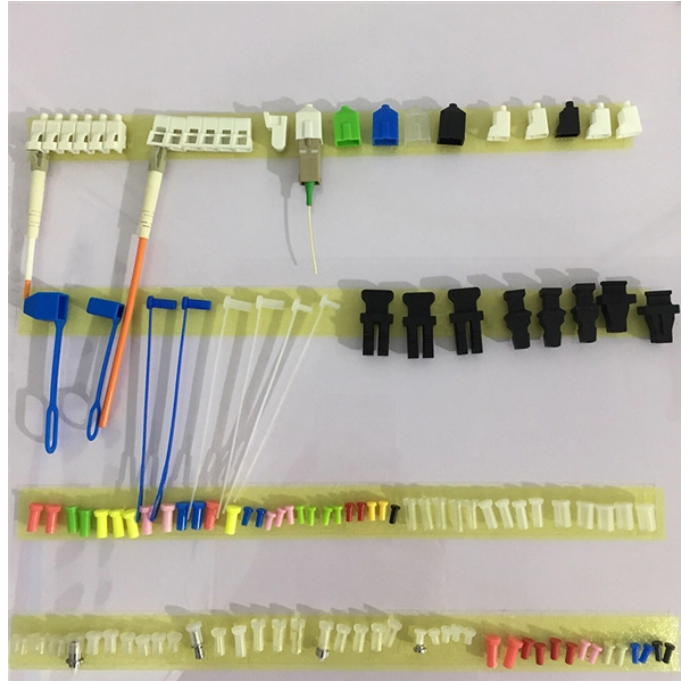


Overview

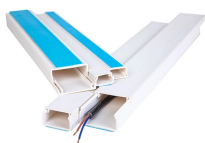
