Overview

Faidherbe Bridge (French: Pont Faidherbe) is a road bridge over the Senegal River which links the island of the city of Saint-Louis in Senegal to the African mainland. The metal bridge is 507.5 m (34 ft) wide, weighing 1,500 t (1,500 long tons; 1,700 short tons). 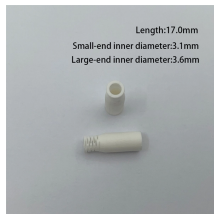
