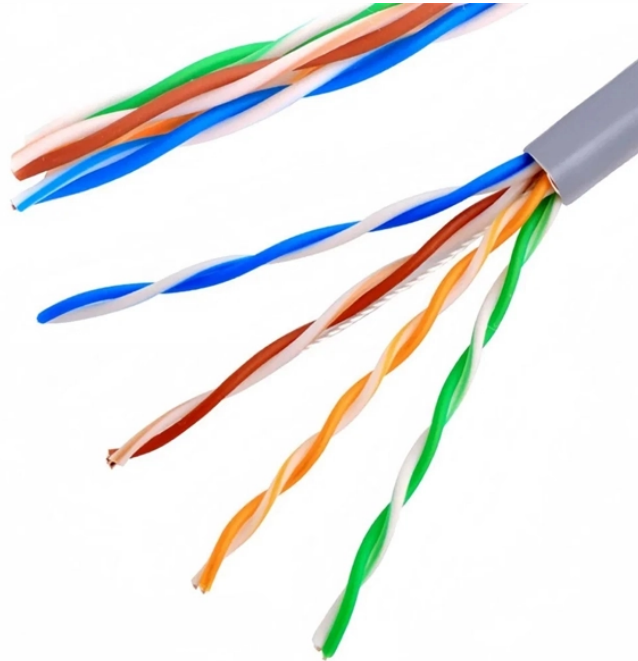


Singapore fiber optic cable collapse and disruption

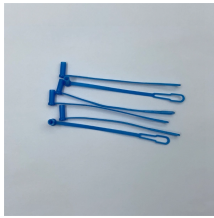


Overview

Asia Piling Co damaged fibre cables, causing a 20-hour outage affecting over 5,000 households. Incident occurred during North-South Corridor construction involving bored piling works. Experts call for stricter enforcement, improved detection, and updated infrastructure mapping. SINGAPORE – Asia Piling, a company involved in many public and commercial projects here, is the sub-contractor that hit critical underground fibre-optic cables. SINGAPORE: Asia Piling Co was the sub-contractor that damaged fibre optic cables and caused a broadband service outage over the weekend, the Land Transport Authority (LTA) said on Wednesday (Apr 22). Around 5,000 users in parts of Ang Mo Kio, Bishan, Sengkang and Punggol were affected by the Apr 18. The bus arrival timing disruption was fully restored on April 19 only after the damaged cable was repaired. 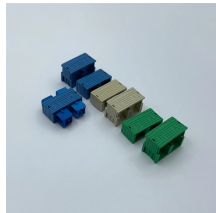
