Financed by the International Development Association (IDA*) with a total of \$76.3 million, ASCENT-Sudan aims to provide electricity and enhanced internet access to 150,000 people, installing 500 renewable energy systems in public spaces, farms, telecom networks, and small. WASHINGTON, June 2, 2025 — The World Bank Board of Executive Directors recently approved the Accelerating Sustainable and Clean Energy and Digital Access Transformation project for Sudan (ASCENT-Sudan) which aims to expand energy access and digital services in Gadaref, Kassala, Northern and River. 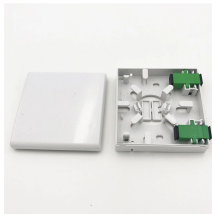
