Overview

The elevator equipment room for a hydraulic elevator is located on the lowest floor closest to the elevator shaft. A (n) ____ shall be located at the point of entry to an elevator machine room. Overcurrent devices and disconnects must be located in machine or control spaces, be lockable and provide a single means to disconnect ungrounded conductors, with selective coordination for multi-elevator feeders. Conductor and wireway fill, approved flexible traveling cables and secure supports. To address this issue, Code Making Panel (CMP) 12 of the National Electrical Code® acted on several proposed changes to Article 620 during the revision cycle for the 2017 NEC that deal with the proper installation of elevator controllers. Heating pipes shall convey only low pressure steam (5 psi (34 kpa) or less) or hot water (212o F (100o C) or less). Each manufacturer has specific requirements for providing power and maintenance access to the equipment.

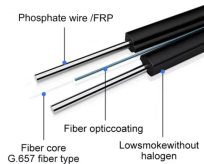

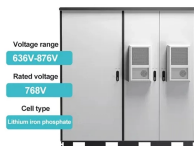

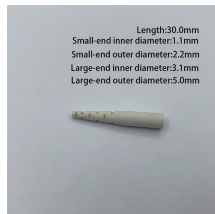

	<p>The installation of all electrical wiring in hoistways and machine rooms, except as may be provided elsewhere in these regulations, shall comply with CCR, Title 24, Part 3, Article 620.</p>
	<p>Elevator, car that moves in a vertical shaft to carry passengers or freight between the levels of a multistory building. Most modern elevators are propelled by electric motors, with the aid of ...</p>
	<p>Locate elevator CR directly adjacent to, and outside of, the elevator hoistway. For a single elevator, provide a minimum CR size of 40 sq. ft., with a minimum of one interior wall length of 7 feet.</p>
	<p>Machine room-less elevator installations incorporate the elevator controller and often the primary disconnecting means in a convenient package that is located within the elevator shaft.</p>
