The passive optical device for power splitting is



For every 2X increase in split ratio, power is reduced by roughly 3 dB. In most cases, the power out of each leg is equal, but we'll discuss a version where the power coming out is unequal amongst legs.



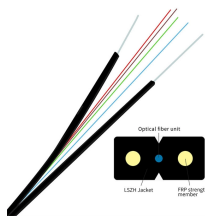
Splitters are passive optical devices that divide or combine optical signals, and they come in various types, including power splitters, uneven splitters, and wavelength-division multiplexing (WDM) splitters.



A passive optical splitter operates entirely in the optical domain. It uses physical structures such as planar lightwave circuits or fused fibers to divide light into multiple paths.



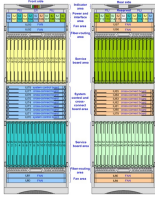

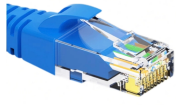
Passive optical devices manage the flow of data through a fiber optic network. Optical splitters, also referred to as couplers, distribute a single incoming light signal into multiple output fibers.
