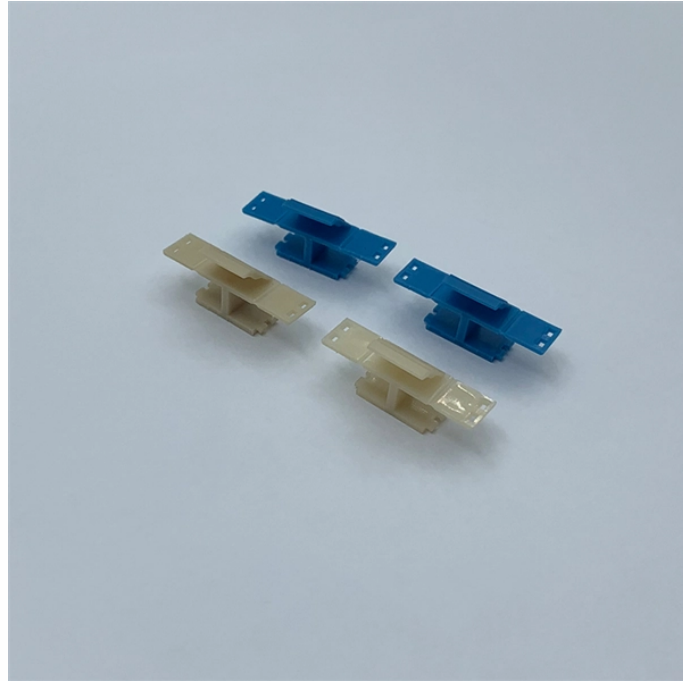


## What does it mean when the fiber optic light on a router is lit



### Overview

This light shows whether your ONT is getting power. What to check: Make sure the power cable is securely plugged into both the ONT and a working wall outlet. Understanding LED Indicators on a Fiber Router Let's break down what the common LED lights on a fiber router mean and how they behave: 1. POWER Normal: Solid/stagnant light. If OFF: The router is not powered — check the socket, adapter, or power cable. No Light: The ONT is not receiving. Whether your modem is blinking orange, your router has a solid red light, or you are staring at a mysterious "DS" indicator, you will find the answer below.

Not sure what the lights on your fiber equipment mean? This guide explains each status light and how to troubleshoot common issues.



On the back of the router, check the On/Off button to confirm that it's powered On. If the lights are off despite your router being correctly plugged in and powered on, contact Technical Support at the ...



Ensure your Fiber Jack is connected to the network and the LED lights are connected and working properly before moving on to troubleshoot your router. Likewise, your router will have to be ...



Also labeled as WAN (Wide Area Network) or PON (Passive Optical Network) on fiber equipment, this light confirms you have an active internet connection. When solid green or white, ...



If the internet light on your ONT is flashing, it could mean that the device is trying to establish a connection to the fiber-optic network. This is usually a normal part of the startup process, ...



Broadband light (solid green): DSL or fiber connection is established. Broadband light (blinking green): The gateway is training or syncing with the DSL/fiber signal.

The internet light, also sometimes labeled WAN or PON (fiber only) or with a globe icon, signifies a connection to the internet. The internet light usually appears right after the upstream data ...



Green or white lights on a modem or router generally indicate normal operation. Orange, amber, or red lights typically signal a partial connection, hardware error, or lost signal — though the ...



Fiber optic networks use light to transmit data, and the PON light specifically indicates the connection to this network. When the PON light is on and stable, it means that the router is successfully connected ...
