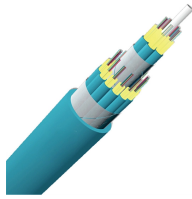

Industrial-grade outdoor fiber optic cables with armor protection. Multiple configurations for long-distance transmission. Commercial building installations with 100-200 network drops generally range from \$15,000 to \$30,000. Fiber. Typical project ranges for running fiber span from a few hundred dollars for short, indoors or overhead runs to tens of thousands for urban street crossings and long outdoor trenching. A simple 1,000 ft outdoor run with ducting and splices might fall in the \$4,000-\$9,000 band, while longer. Several fiber cables are available, each with a different cost based on fiber type, construction, and application.

Prices typically range from about \$0.60 to \$3.50 per foot for fiber optic cable and basic installation, depending on indoor vs outdoor routing, distance, and terrain.
