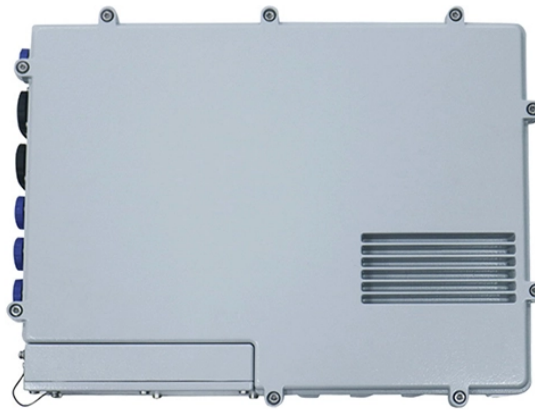


# What s that smell inside the electrical distribution box
